REGULATIONS AND PENALTIES FOR RESIDENTS AND CONTRACTORS WHO CAUSE FIRE ALARMS AT THE DEVON

We have two primary causes of fire alarms at the Devon:

- 1. Contractors who do not comply with written Devon construction guidelines by requesting fire alarm deactivation.
- 2. Residents who do not close the bedroom doors when cooking.

Effective February 1, 2018, contractors who do not secure written approval from the Devon office to proceed with their work projects, sign-in daily, and who do not arrange for fire alarm deactivation <u>will be fined \$500</u> should a false alarm result from not complying with Devon guidelines.

Owners who are cooking must close the bedroom doors. The alarms located in the bedroom(s) are hard-wired to the Fire Department and necessitate Fire Department response. Fire alarms located in the living room are local alarms to which the doorman will respond to gauge the seriousness of the situation.

Effective February 1, 2018, the Devon will track owners who cause false alarms. The first false alarm will be recorded and there will be no disciplinary action. <u>Any additional alarms will result in the owner being fined \$100 for the first infraction and \$250 for any subsequent infractions.</u>

All Devon residents can obtain a kitchen magnet in the Devon office with a reminder "WHEN COOKING CLOSE BEDROOM DOORS".
