Pool

The Devon pool is usually open from Memorial Day to Labor Day. All owners and residents are considered members and are invited to use the pool. Members are asked to sign in and present identification tags, which are available at no charge at the beginning of each season. Guests are welcome; they must present an owner's tag or a guest pass. All members and guests are required to follow pool rules and observe common courtesies. The exact opening and closing date and the pool hours are announced by the Devon Council annually in May.

In mid-May pool tags and guest cards may be obtained from the Devon office at any time during office hours (8:00 a.m. — 3:30 p.m.). If you cannot come during office hours, call and make arrangements to obtain them.

IN ORDER TO RECEIVE NEW POOL TAGS. ALL PREVIOUS POOL TAGS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE OFFICE.

Pool Policy

- 1. Pool membership is available only to property owners.
- 2. Renters are considered to be guests, at no charge, of their unit owners and are entitled to all pool privileges available to the owners.
- 3. Residents and owners, upon request, will be issued two member tags and one 4-visit guest card per unit at no charge.
- 4. Anyone may use the member tag or guest card resident, family member or guest.
- 5. When the initial guest card is used up, residents and owners may obtain up to two additional cards at no charge by turning the used card in to the Devon office. Only one guest card is permitted at a time. Additional cards are \$8 for 4 visits.
- 6. Anyone 13 and over must have a member tag or a guest card to enter the pool enclosure. If anyone arrives at the pool without either of these, they will not be admitted.
- 7. Guest cards must be presented to the lifeguard, who will punch the card and stamp the guest's hand.
- 8. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult and are admitted free. Responsibility for children rests with the adult.
- 9. For ten minutes each hour, the pool will be cleared for an '18 or over only' swim.

- 1. The Lifeguard on duty has complete authority within the pool enclosure.
- 2. The pool will open daily (weather permitting), as per annual schedule.
- **3.** Persons are permitted in pool only when Lifeguard is present.
- **4.** Everyone entering the pool enclosure must sign in with the Lifeguard.
- 5. Everyone 13 and over must have a pool tag or quest card when in the pool enclosure.
- 6. An adult must accompany every two children under age 12. Responsibility for children rests with the adult. The Lifeguard has sole discretion to require that an adult remain with a child when in the pool.
- 7. Any child who is not potty-trained must wear *Huggies* "Little Swimmers" (they can be obtained at the pool for \$1.00 and owner will be billed later) in order to enter the water. Disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool.
- 8. Persons wearing suntan lotion <u>must</u> use towels when occupying a lounge or chair.
- 9. Persons wishing to use free flotation devices or underwater swimming equipment must first check with Lifeguard. Water floatation devices used by children (particularly arm bands) are permitted only if the accompanying adult is within tangible reach of that child at all times.
- **10.** Diving from pool deck must be in the diving area only.
- **11.** Persons incapable of swimming two lengths of the pool with ease and confidence will not be permitted beyond the shallow end.
- **12.** For ten minutes each hour, on the hour, the pool will be cleared for an '18 or over only swim.
- 13. Any act, which could result in personal injury, either to oneself or to others, is prohibited. For example: running, pushing, throwing, dunking, etc.
- **14.** All personal injuries, regardless of how slight or minor, must be reported to Lifeguard on duty.
- **15.** Food or drink is not allowed in or near the pool. These should be kept at the chairs or tables. **Absolutely no glass allowed** within the fenced pool area.
- **16.** No loud radios, which may be offensive to others.
- **17.** Cabana deck is for use by cabana renters only.
- **18.** Special arrangements for use of Pool area can be made with the Devon office in advance.
- **19.** Pool phone must be kept available for emergency use: personal and business calls must be limited to 2 minutes.

Pool Cabanas

There are 13 cabanas at the pool that are rented to residents at a present charge of \$305 per year. Anyone renting a cabana has first option to rent the same cabana for the next season. There are presently 6 people on the waiting list; the last cabana changed hands in May 2014. If you would like your name added to the waiting list, please contact the Devon office.

Guidelines for Private Pool Parties

- 1. Request form must be obtained from the Devon office, filled out and returned to the office with at least three weeks notice.
- 2. Pool is available Monday through Sunday during regular hours, and from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., and mornings from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- 3. Parties scheduled during regular pool hours, may need an additional guard that will be billed to you at the current hourly rate.
- 4. A minimum of two lifeguards is required (one guard per 25 guests). The responsible resident will be billed for the lifeguards at the current hourly rate by the Devon office.
- 5. Your guests must follow all pool rules.
- 6. Pool area must be cleaned and returned to its normal condition by the responsible resident within ^XA hour of party conclusion no later than 10:30 p.m.
- 7. Lifeguard must lock the gates and be the last to leave.
- 8. Loud entertainment and unruly behavior is not permitted.
- 9. No glass of any kind within pool enclosure.
- 10. Outside guests must park on the street and not within the Devon lots.

At end of party, checklist must be completed and signed by resident and lifeguards. Resident then returns the form to the Devon office.
